



They were married at Peoria, Ill. abt 1858.

HEALTH: George died of cancer at Plattsmouth, Nebraska on 4/8/1904.

POLITICS: George was active in the "SINGLE TAX LEAGUE", the product of a man known as "the prophet of San Francisco" and "the new prophet of righteousness in the 19th century". His name: Henry George.

FRATERNAL ORGANIZATIONS: A member of both the Masons and International Order Of Odd Fellows (I.O.O.F.).

NOTE: A booklet, issued by his children in his memory, exists which gives some family history and details. It states that the "SINGLE TAX LEAGUE" [above] became his "religion". It seems to have been a utopian social order like communism. His daughter and grand daughter carried on the fight against the "unfair distribution of wealth" until they both died in a steamship accident. [see the booklet "NAKE"].
